## **NOTES**

Our future expenditure for the remainder of this year is approximately £3514 When all remaining items are paid/received, we will have total funds available of approx £9.900, which is appropriate in the circumstances. Due to potential financial obligations re Village Hall, playground maintenance, potential Councillors election costs as well as the ever increasing traffic issues, it is suggested to create earmarked funds in case of unforeseen financial issues arising.

Once these funds are at their appropriate level the precept can be accordingly adjusted.

During the current Financial Year, a sizeable donation was received from Clarke & Simpson for use of the playing field as car parking on 2 occasions, which has been placed in a reserved fund to help Village causes/projects. While not guaranteed, it has been implied that a similar arrangement will apply for for the coming financial year.

Committee proposes that local Village Organisations be again approached to invite them to submit funding proposals after the January meeting for consideration at the March Meeting

The Committee therefore recommends a Precept Application of £5,500.
