

MEETING NOTES of ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE of CAMPSEA ASHE PC, WEDNESDAY 9th February 2022, 17.30

EC21.05 Public Participation

Members of the public were invited to comment throughout the meeting, as all participants were volunteers linked to WAC.

EC21.06 Sub-Committee & Terms of Reference

1 The Environmental Committee consisting of three members of the PC (CR;SW;EB), with the Sub-Committee consisting of four members, one of which being a member of the PC (SW). Deborah Ireland, Olli Webb and Peter Marrett volunteered to be part of the Sub-Committee and the EC accepted their inclusion. The Sub Committee will call meetings as are required and without any official notice period.

2 It was agreed to name the Sub-committee as the E WAC (Sub) - committee.

3 The clerk read out the structure and Terms of Reference for the Committee and WAC Sub-Committee. The EC adopted the terms of reference as presented to the meeting, which will be made public on the PC's website.

EC21.07 Current Project

1 WAC / PM showed plans of the Community Garden project, which included fruit trees, Jubilee Tree and a Garden House to use as a base for special activities with residents. Phase1, for which a £2000 grant has been applied for the PC, will be the creation of a raised planting area by the WAC volunteers, followed by a hut/ garden house and subsequent refinement of the area. It was pointed out that it would be prudent to have a co-ordinated masterplan for the full project, which should include possible expansion over the next years, otherwise it might start to look incohesive.

2 Co-ordination with the VH Committee was also deemed important, as the land utilised as either owned by the PC or by the VH Committee.

3 CR did mention the ambition of the PC to have a Boules court installed by June near the Play area and it was agreed to co-ordinate this with WAC and the VH.
